Why Attend a Summer Program at UDallas?

2026 High School Summer Programs

SUMMER ART ACADEMY

The UDallas Summer Art Academy is an opportunity for art students to immerse themselves in the language and techniques of art making, expanding their abilities and developing their artistic potential. Students will explore multiple art mediums in the various studios on campus, creating an intensive, enriching and rewarding experience.

SUMMER MUSIC ACADEMY

The UDallas Summer Music Academy immerses students of piano, strings and voice in the language of music. University of Dallas Music Department faculty will work with students in a variety of settings, including private lessons, master classes, music theory classes and ensembles.

COLLEGE CITIZENS

The UDallas College Citizens Program is open to rising high school seniors in the Dallas/Fort Worth area who would be the first in their families to earn a bachelor's degree. Students will engage in two rigorous weeks of in-depth reading, writing and discussion about social topics of fundamental importance: What is citizenship? What does it mean to seek a virtuous life? What is our responsibility to others?

ARETE: AN INTRODUCTION TO THE CLASSICS

The Arete Program engages questions of excellence and the noble life through the essential texts of Western civilization, including the works of Plato, Shakespeare and Douglass. Along with participating in reading groups and developing a final paper, students will view films, visit art museums and attend live productions.

The PEAK summer program introduces high school students to the Wyoming Catholic College experience. Participants briefly, yet intensely witness our life of integrated intellectual formation, outdoor exploration in God's First Book, and whole-person spiritual development.

All participants must bring a deep desire to explore, academically and experientially, the meaning and beauty of God's Creation. Activities include academic classes, team sports and rock climbing, a 4-day backpacking trip in the Rocky Mountains, a dance and formal dinner, and daily Mass and spiritual formation.

The total PEAK cost includes tuition, room, and board (not including travel to WCC). Completed applications received on or before March 1st will qualify for a \$300 Early-Bird Discount.

PEAK participants may also be eligible for our \$1,000 campus visit credit upon enrollment.
