

# Text to Speech ACCOMMODATIONS GUIDE

## For the CLT and the CLT10:

The test platform has a built-in Text to Speech (TTS) tool. A banner across the top of the exam instructs the student to highlight any text or math to hear it read aloud. This will automatically appear only on the sections for which the student has been approved to use TTS. The student's test must be taken from the same account (email) under which they were approved for accommodations.

## For the CLT3-8:

### Speechify (CLT3-8)

- Pin this extension in your browser.
- Either push the play button that appears by each paragraph or select text and push play.
- Read the answers alongside Speechify. The answer letters are pushed up against the previous answer.
- Be sure to read along in the math section, as this does not read numbers well.

### Talkie (CLT3-8)

- Please pin this extension in your browser.
- Select text, then push the Talkie play button in the toolbar.
- This one is hard to resume, if stopped. Just highlight the next bit of text you need to read, and push play again.
- Be sure to read along in the math section, as this does not read symbols well.
