

## OF THE CLT

The CLT is a college entrance exam for 11th and 12th graders and an alternative to the SAT® and ACT®. It can be taken online or on paper and assesses reading, grammar, writing, and mathematics. The CLT is accepted at hundreds of colleges across the United States and abroad.

## **Contains 3 sections:**

- Verbal Reasoning (40 minutes)
  - 40 questions of textual comprehension and textual analysis
- Grammar/Writing (35 minutes)
  - o 40 questions of grammatical editing and improvement
- Quantitative Reasoning (45 minutes)
  - 40 questions of logic and mathematics

The "classic" in Classic Learning Test refers to our emphasis on timeless, foundational skills in language arts and mathematics, as well as our use of classic literature and historical texts for the majority of reading content on our exams. Assessing intellectual aptitude and achievement, the CLT is designed to fit a variety of educational backgrounds, including homeschool, private, charter, and more.
