PAPER CLT3-6 EXAMS

CLT3, CLT4, CLT5, and CLT6 are formative and summative assessments designed for 3rd-6th grade students. The exams provide in-depth analytics reports that equip educators and help inform instruction.

The **paper CLT3-6 exams** contain four sections:

1. Verbal Reasoning: Grammar
 - Orthography, parts of speech, and sentence structure & diagramming
2. Verbal Reasoning: Reading Comprehension and Writing
 - Textual analysis, reading comprehension, and writing concepts & skills
3. Quantitative Reasoning: Math Content
 - Arithmetic and mathematical operations, including content (achievement) skills in number sense, operations, measurement, and properties of shapes
4. Quantitative Reasoning: Reasoning Skills
 - Geometrical and mathematical reasoning, including logic and word problems

The “classic” in Classic Learning Test refers to our emphasis on timeless, foundational skills in language arts and mathematics, as well as our use of classic literature and historical texts for the majority of reading content on our exams. CLT3, 4, 5, and 6 feature rich and engaging reading passages for young learners, including classic children’s literature, fables, poetry, historical non-fiction, and more. Assessing intellectual aptitude and achievement, CLT3-6 are a great fit for students from a variety of educational backgrounds, including classical, private, charter, and more.

CLT3-6 can be taken in-school during a window of dates offered once in the fall and once in the spring. Partner schools that administer CLT3-6 receive full support from the Classic Learning Test (CLT) team before and after testing. This includes special pricing, analytics reports for individual students and the entire testing group, and a dedicated CLT representative to assist with the testing process and analytics interpretation.
