An Overview of the ONLINE CLT3-6 EXAMS

CLT3, CLT4, CLT5, and CLT6 are formative and summative assessments designed for 3rd-6th grade students. The exams provide in-depth analytics reports that equip educators and help inform instruction.

The **online CLT3-6 exams** contain two sections:

1. Verbal Reasoning

- Covers **reading comprehension and analysis skills** such as main idea, structure, themes and point of view, supporting arguments, finding details, and grade-appropriate vocabulary in context, as well as **grammar skills** in spelling, punctuation, capitalization, word morphology, parts of speech, and sentence structure.

2. Quantitative Reasoning

- Covers **arithmetic and mathematical computations**, including content skills in number sense, operations, measurement, and properties of shapes, as well as **reasoning skills** in logic and word problems.

The “classic” in Classic Learning Test refers to our emphasis on timeless, foundational skills in language arts and mathematics, as well as our use of classic literature and historical texts for the majority of reading content on our exams. CLT3, 4, 5, and 6 feature rich and engaging reading passages for young learners, including classic children’s literature, fables, poetry, historical non-fiction, and more. Assessing intellectual aptitude and achievement, CLT3-6 are a great fit for students from a variety of educational backgrounds, including classical, private, charter, and more.

CLT3-6 can be taken in-school during a window of dates offered in the fall, winter, and spring. Partner schools that administer CLT3-6 receive full support from the Classic Learning Test (CLT) team before and after testing.
