Overview for Florida Students

Classic Learning Test (CLT) provides a distinct approach to standardized testing, assessing both **aptitude** (innate ability) and **achievement** (acquired knowledge). Additionally, CLT exams are designed to promote **critical thinking** and engage students with reading passages from **history's best authors and thinkers**.

CLT for GRADES 11-12

The CLT is a college entrance exam and SAT/ACT alternative that assesses reading, writing, grammar, and mathematics.

Florida students can utilize the CLT to:

- apply to state colleges and universities, as well as 300+ CLT Partner Colleges
- earn Bright Futures scholarships
- qualify for dual enrollment
- meet state testing concordance for graduation

CLT10 for GRADES 9-10

The CLT10 is a college preparatory exam and PSAT/PreACT alternative that assesses reading, writing, grammar, and mathematics.

Florida students can utilize the CLT10 to:

- qualify for dual enrollment
- meet state testing concordance for graduation
- qualify for the \$2,500 CLT10 National Award Scholarship

BRIGHT FUTURES

Florida Academic Scholarship (FAS)

- **2026 Grads** - Eligible with a 95 CLT or above
- **2027 Grads** - Eligible with a 95 CLT or above

Florida Medallion Scholarship (FMS)


- **2026 Grads** - Eligible with an 82 CLT or above
- **2027 Grads** - Eligible with an 82 CLT or above



DUAL ENROLLMENT

Students can use scores earned from the CLT and CLT10 to qualify for dual enrollment college courses.
